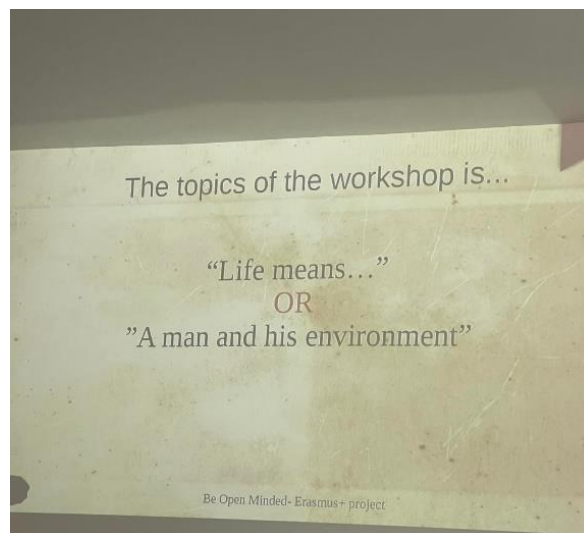
DAY 2

Square (Plac Niepodległości), with historic residential and industrial buildings of the nineteenth and early twentieth century clustered around it.

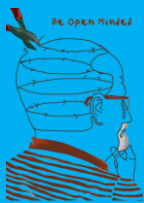

DAY 4

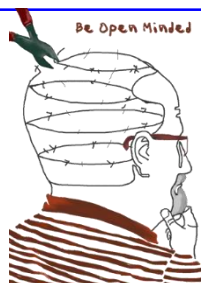
